Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach the last week before we break up for half term we would like to remind and inform you about a few things taking place.

## **RHE – Relationship and Health Education**

The delivery of RHE is a statutory requirement for primary schools and in 2019, the school held extensive consultation with parents when revising the scheme of work. This week you will receive a letter from your child's teacher outlining the coverage taking place in each unit using the scheme 'Ten Ten'. ## Asthma

As part of accepted good practice and with advice from the Department for Education and Asthma UK, our school will be continuing a School Asthma Policy for use by all staff and will use the 'Asthma Card' which parents/carers are required to complete. If your child has asthma please collect a card from your class teacher or the school office. If you have completed a card previously and the circumstances have not changed there is no need to complete a new one.

Children who have 'reliever' inhalers in school are permitted to keep them on their person, in their tray, bag or locker. It is expected that they are aware of the signs of needing an inhaler and can administer it themselves. Obviously younger children will be given support if required.
